WHY WORK AT AIDS CONNECTICUT?

At AIDS Connecticut, we work with our member agencies to improve the lives of people impacted by HIV/AIDS through care and supportive services, housing assistance, advocacy, trainings, and prevention. WHAT WILL YOU DO AS TREATMENT ADHERENCE NURSE?

You will do a lot! Most importantly, you will provide treatment adherence assistance to HIV-positive clients. In accordance with Department of Public Health and ACT protocols, you will conduct initial and ongoing assessments of clients including level of medication adherence and motivations and barriers to adherence. With the client, you will develop a care plan to address barriers to treatment adherence. Coordination with client's care team is of the utmost importance.

You will also collect and input data into CAREWare, the electronic health record system we use. You will have the opportunity to provide health education and facilitate adherence support groups for clients. Finally, you will help complete program reports where you outline the successes and challenges of the treatment adherence program.

REQUIREMENT:

- Current Connecticut RN license

- Are comfortable working in a sex positive environment where HIV/STIs, sexual behavior, and prophylaxis are routinely discussed

- Experience working in a fast pace environment and ability to respond to change quickly
- Have strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Have strong organizational and time management skills
- Are able to work collaboratively and independently
- Are able to work with limited supervision (face to face and/or virtual)
