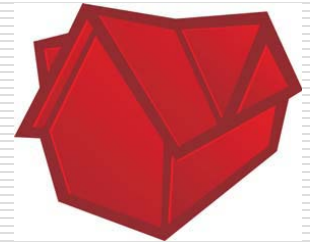
- Case Management Institute

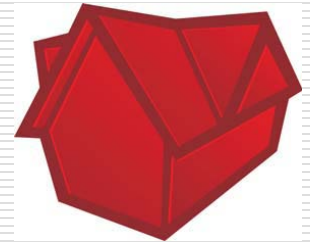

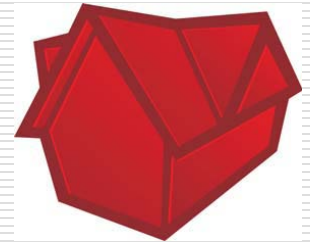
